We take this special opportunity to thank all friends and well-wishers who have been supporting the children of Rainbow House of Hope Uganda to attain their education path. Due to Covid - 19 pandemic the students were stopped from attending classes and this affected them academically more especially the candidate classes that were expecting to do their final exams. Rainbow house of Hope staff reacted immediately by creating mobile learning library by providing the reading materials and giving the children weekly home work in order to keep them busy reading and not to forget passed covered work.

Am happy to inform you that we are currently supporting 47 children and out of 47 students' two children attend kindergarten, 25 attend primary level, 11 students at secondary level, 3 at university level and six at tertiary level. We have registered six students who successfully completed their final exams at senior four and five students who completed

their primary leaving exams and one student completed her Diploma course in Nursing and Midwifery. This has been achieved due to your continued support and we expect better results in two months ahead.

Before Victor joined Myros of skills training, he was working as a security guard. However, the payments were very low and he decided to take up hands on skills training.

Victor enrolled for welding course for six months training. He completed the training graduated and received recognized Certificate from Directorate of Industrial Training (DIT)

Right now, Victor joined a friend and opened welding workshop and this is what victor had to say.

“I am so regretful for Rainbow giving an opportunity that has drastically changed my life. Before this skill I used to earn very little money with a lot pressure but now after learning from rainbow, my income is stable and I have the freedom to do other small side work that brings that additional income into my pocket”
